DESCRIPTION

Licorice Root-V, provided by Douglas Laboratories, supplies 300 mg of deglycyrrhizinated licorice root per each vegetarian capsule.

FUNCTIONS

Licorice has been used in Traditional Chinese Medicine for hundreds of years to support the body, including the gastrointestinal system. It was often used as a demulcent, to soothe and coat the stomach and throat. Deglycyrrhizinated licorice is designed to provide the supportive benefits of licorice while reducing intake of potentially unwanted glycyrrhizin.
